During these years I did an internship at the Alcorcón Foundation University Hospital and the Móstoles Multiple Sclerosis Association. After finishing the degree, I continued my studies with the Master in Motor Neurocontrol, where I specialized in the evaluation and rehabilitation of patients with neurological pathologies. I practiced my profession in different centers. In 2021 I started working in a geriatric clinic with patients with neurological pathologies such as parkinson, stroke, alzheimer and neurodegenerative diseases. In 2022, I started working in a day center for the elderly with physical pathologies and sensory deficiencies. During these years I was tutor of practices of students of the Degree in Occupational Therapy of the Rey Juan Carlos University. I also did home rehabilitation for patients with neurodegenerative diseases and cerebral palsy. In September 2022 I started working at the National Hospital for Paraplegics of Toledo, in the Functional Exploration and Neuromodulation of the Nervous System (FENNSI) group. In this group, my career in clinical research began with the evaluation of plasticity in patients with spinal cord injury using transcranial magnetic stimulation, the evaluation of brain waves in electroencephalogram studies in pain patients undergoing neuromodulation treatments.
